

## TEAMER Post Access Requirements

All Technical Support Recipients (TSR) are required to complete the following Post Access Requirements upon the completion of their TEAMER support. Failure to complete these items may limit participants future TEAMER opportunities.

- Submission and revision (if necessary) of a Post Access Report • Upload data to the Marine Hydrokinetic Data Repository (MHKDR).
- Complete a Post Access Questionnaire

### Post Access Report

TSR's are responsible for submitting a Post Access Report upon the completion of their technical support activities. Depending on the nature of the work, TSR's may work with the facility to complete this report, however it will be the responsibility of the TSR to coordinate and submit the report. All reports will be reviewed by the TEAMER Technical Board for completeness and to ensure the work product is clear and concise.

Reports should be submitted to the TEAMER Network Director at [teamer@pacificoceanenergy.org](mailto:teamer@pacificoceanenergy.org). TSR's may submit two versions of the report if necessary to protect sensitive Intellectual Property. Public versions will be summarized on the TEAMER website and archived on the Portal and Repository for Information on Marine Renewable Energy (PRIMRE) by the Network Director. Private versions will be reviewed by the TEAMER Technical Board and stored securely.

### Upload data to the Marine Hydrokinetic Data Repository (MHKDR).

TSR's are required to upload to the TEAMER DOE Marine and Hydrokinetic Data Repository:

- data demonstrating progress towards meeting the objectives identified in Sections 6 (Project Summary) & 8 (Assistance Data) of the TSR application
- all scripts and data used to generate all figures, tables, and charts in the final report. TSRs are advised that artificially limiting the number of figures in the final report (to avoid disclosing underlying data) will be considered non-compliance with final reporting requirements and will not be approved.

TSR's may choose to protect the data for up to five years, at which time the data will be made public. This data moratorium is consistent with DOE's data requirements for funding. TEAMER Technical Board members will have access to view the data to ensure it complies with the listed requirements.

#### Post Access Questionnaire

Both the TSR and a member of the Facility should each complete and submit a Post Access Survey Questionnaire. There are two separate survey forms depending on if the project was from [RFTS rounds 1-7](#), or [RFTS 8+ and Open Water RFTS](#).

Upon successful completion of these listed requirements, the Request for Technical Support will be considered complete.
